BUT A TIP FOR EXCELLENT SERVICE IS ALWAYS APPRECIATED

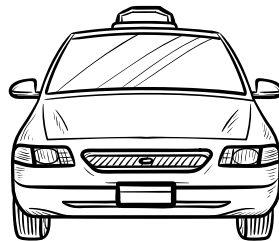
TIP WITH CASH, NOT A CREDIT CARD

YOU DON'T NEED TO TIP THE OWNER



WHO TO TIP	HOW MUCH TO TIP	HOW TO LEAVE TIP
waiter (restaurant)	A few €; 10% in high-end restaurants	Leave € on the table or with the cashier
barista (taking coffee standing up)	Round up to nearest €	Leave the coin on your receipt at the counter
waiter (café), sitting down	Round up to nearest €	Leave € on the table
taxi driver	Round up €1-2	Tell driver to keep change
private driver	€5 pickup/dropoff; 10% full day	Give € at end of service
tour guide	€5-10 per person	Give € at end of tour
porter	€1/bag or €5 flat tip	Give € after delivery
conciierge	€5-10	Hand € to conciierge on departure
housekeeper	€1/day	Leave € on nightstand daily or at end of stay
bartender	Round up to nearest €	Tell bartender to keep change
massage therapist	10%*	Leave € with cashier
hairstresser	10%*	Leave € with cashier
parking lot attendant	€1	Hand € to attendant
private chef	10% of food bill	Hand € in envelope at end of evening/trip
food delivery person	€3-5, more for large orders	Hand € to delivery person when food is received
gas station attendant	No tip	Gas price is higher for serviced pump
owner	No tip	We don't tip owners in Italy
